Pre-ETS Jeopardy LESSON Plan

This lesson is designed to introduce and/or review Pre-Employment Transition Services (Pre-ETS) vocabulary to your students. Download the lesson plan and play the game with your students using zoom, hangouts or any other platform you use to with your students!

Pro Tip: Play the game more than once (e.g., play every few weeks). This will help your students become familiar with the terms and language and apply these terms outside the school setting.

Lesson Objective: Students will play a Jeopardy game to review knowledge of Vocational Rehabilitation Pre-Employment Transition Services.

- 1. What are Pre-Employment Transition Skills (Pre-ETS):
 - a. Pre-ETS Definition: Services provided by Vocational Rehabilitation that allows students to explore 5 skill areas. Pre-ETS Skills (clicking on each skill will direct you to WINTAC website).
 - i. Job exploration counseling
 - ii. Work-based learning experiences, which may include in-school or after school opportunities, experiences outside of the traditional school setting, and/or internships
 - iii. Counseling on opportunities for enrollment in comprehensive transition or postsecondary educational programs
 - iv. Workplace readiness training to develop social skills and independent living
 - v. Instruction in self-advocacy
 - b. Students do not need to be clients of VR to receive services; students need to be potentially eligible for VR
 - c. Introduce Pre-ETS by using the Pre-ETS PowerPoint and Interview for Students
- 2. Play Jeopardy Game!
 - a. Teacher shares screen with Jeopardy game: https://www.playfactile.com/preemploymentjeopardy
 - b. Divide students in 2 or more teams (each team should have 2 to 4 players)
 - c. Pick a team to go first.

- i. Teacher unmutes team who goes first. All other players should be muted.
- ii. After team plays, it is the next team's turn.
- iii. Keep playing until all questions/categories are completed or time runs out.
- 3. Have students complete Pre-ETS Review Worksheet
 - a. Students can complete worksheet independently
 - b. Teacher can check in to help make referrals to VR for Pre-ETS.
 - i. Use Pre-ETS Consent and Release form to make Pre-ETS referrals to VR
