
Highlights below are from graphs on the following page:

- By **Exit Method**, the highest percentage of respondents who achieved a **standard** diploma were engaged in competitive employment (39%), followed by higher education (37%).
- By **Disability Type**, the highest percentage of respondents who received special education services for **specific learning disability** were engaged in competitive employment (492%).
- By **Race/Ethnicity**, the highest percentage of **White** respondents were engaged in competitive employment (38.0%).
- By **Gender**, the highest percentage of **female** respondents were engaged in competitive employment (33.8%).
- Of the 752 respondents who were **not engaged**, 226 (30%) reported enrolling in further education and/or working since leaving high school. However, they did not meet the criteria to be counted in one of the engaged categories. Of these, 28.32% did not complete one term of further education and 47.35% did not work for at least 90 days.






