

# Eligibility for the Post-School Outcomes Follow-Up Interview



This document outlines who is eligible for the Post-School Outcomes Follow-Up Interview.

**Indicator 14 – Percent of youth who are no longer in secondary school, had IEPs in effect at the time they left school, and were:**

- A. Enrolled in higher education within one year of leaving high school.
- B. Enrolled in higher education or competitively employed within one year of leaving high school.
- C. Enrolled in higher education or in some other postsecondary education or training program; or competitively employed or in some other employment within one year of leaving high school. (20 U.S.C. 1416(a)(3)(B))

Oregon school staff collect these data by conducting phone interviews with former students or their designee between June and September. All former students are eligible for the Follow-Up Interview if they:

- ✓ had an IEP in effect when they left school,
  - including those who transferred to homeschool, unless special education services were revoked by a parent or guardian
- ✓ have been out of school for at least 365 days; and
- ✓ exited school by
  - graduating with any diploma or completion document,
  - dropping out of school,
  - aging out of school- reached maximum age, or
  - were expected to return to school and did not.
